Detail of Human Rights Violation in Sindh

Human rights violation is never ending in Sindh, Pakistan, due to less concerned and lack of interest for preventing human rights values and principles in society by the State and as well as by an incumbent government. Ratifying intentional conventions, bills, agreements and signing memorandums with international communities, countries and forums for the protection and promotion of fundamental human rights of the citizens of Pakistan is nothing more than a just fashion show and face saving on the part of state and government.

Recent visit of UN working group on forced disappearances uncovered the real face the undemocratic, non human rights friendly state and government of Pakistan. They clearly shared during the press conference in Islamabad that thousands of human rights activists, political workers and media personnel from across the Pakistan, particularly from the Sindh and Baluchistan have been disappeared by spy agencies of Pakistan finding says, which is the totally inhuman and open human rights violation in the context of local as well as international human rights laws.

State and prevailing government demonstrate that they are only interested into their vested interests and powers to be remained with them and could be transferred hereditary for centuries and but they are least concern with peoples' rights promised in the constitution and international human rights laws. That's why rule of laws sees ineffective and existing so called. Only rule of might is right is in action.

It is a third month September 2012 that **Institute for Social Change** is continuously collecting the data of human rights violation from different local newspapers, but instead of decreasing human rights violation is increasing. In this month September 2012, 368 male, female and children have been killed extrajudicial across the Sind province of Pakistan, whereas, August witnessed 327 deaths across the province, which is open violation of the constitution of Pakistan and but also the denial of agreements and commitments have been made with the regional and international communities and organizations.

Government does not seem to be in action to prevent such human rights violation cases in the Sindh. People are looking for the justice to be given to them. People are looking for peace and security. People are looking for their right to education and their right to live with dignity and respect. They are looking for their right to get equal opportunities and distribution of resources within the framework of Pakistan.
